## Training Leaders for Faith Sharing In Small Groups

### 1. Publicize Leader Training Sessions

- a. In bulletin, parish website, and pulpit announcement
- b. Schedule more than one session to give people more options.

## 2. Group Leader Training Session

- 1. Welcome leaders.
- 2. Have introductions.
- 3. Make sure each leader has a copy Disciples on the Journey (DJ), the Lenten resource to be used in the parish.
- 4. If possible have group lists and enough copies of Disciples on the Journey books for each leader's group.
- 5. The group lists should have phone numbers, emails, and addresses of those participating in each group.
- 6. Have a handout with the following information.
  - a. Group leaders:
    - 1.are not teaching or explaining the Scriptures to the group.
    - 2. are facilitators who help their small faith sharing process run smoothly.
    - 3. help everyone to feel welcomed and at ease
    - **4.** invite everyone in their group to participate without forcing or embarrassing anyone.
    - 5. may invite group members to take turns providing light refreshments for the sessions.
    - **6**. could provide refreshments for the first session or ask another group member to do this
    - 7. usually host the sessions in their home, but could invite group members to take turns hosting the sessions
    - 8. usually lead the sessions, but can take turns with others to lead the process
    - 9. need to read each session in advance and make sure that everything is ready for the prayer table and prayer rituals.

# 7. Group Leader Training Sessions

- a. Begin with an opening prayer. Preferably the prayer in Session One for the First Sunday of Lent.
- b. Have group leaders sit in small groups so they can go over the first session in *Disciples on the Journey*

- Lenten Program. This will acquaint them with the resource and better help them know what is expected.
- c. Encourage the leaders to call or email each participant in her/his group to welcome them, reiterating the time, date, and place of the meeting. The leader will need to give the participants her address and directions to find the home.
- d. Ascertain if the leader can deliver the books to her group a week in advance of the first meeting or prefers to have participants pick up their book at Sunday Mass or at the parish office.

### e. Evaluation

- 1. Have copies of the evaluation available.
- 2. Tell leaders that they are to give the evaluations to participants the second to the last week.
- 3. The leader or another member of the group could collate the evaluations and email them to *Disciples* on the Journey.
- 4. **Optional Collection** This is for parishes that may find it difficult to fund this program.
  - a. At the first meeting with the small group, the leader can announce that a collection will be taken at the last gathering to help the parish pay for the resources.
  - b. At the last meeting, a collection can be taken and the money given to the parish as reimbursement for resources.

### c. Celebration

- ii. Some groups like to have a meal together at the last meeting.
- iii. Other groups prefer to gather after Easter to celebrate a meal together.
- iv. Still other groups might want to continue to meet after Easter and they can decide on this at a meeting after Easter where only those who are interested would attend.
