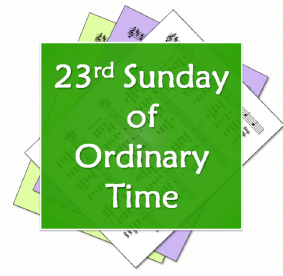


23rd Sunday in Ordinary time Cycle B *Rich in faith*
