Reading I **Wisdom 7:7-11** (Solomon and the riches of wisdom)

Reading II **Hebrew 4:12-13** (God's living word)

Gospel **Mark 10:17-30 or 10:17-27** (the danger of riches - Jesus and the rich man)

Key Passage Jesus said, "It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for someone who is rich to enter the kingdom of God."
(Mark 10:25)

Question of the Week: Can you recall a situation or experience when you realized how the pleasures and comforts of the world can become a barrier to your relationship with God? How did you respond when you became aware of that fact?
